RIGHT TO WORK LEGISLATION "Freedom in the Workplace" Petitions are being circulated and can be held for years. Currently, Gov. Kasich has said that RTW is "not on his radar", but pressure from the Tea Party or a second term could easily change this. There is currently a "So Called Right to Work" Taskforce working on a tool kit and other materials and messaging is being field-tested. There is also some information available on the OEA website.
