Participants in the program may be self-nominated or nominated by others—local association leader, district leader, OEA Board of Directors member, or OEA Labor Relations Consultant. Participation will be fully funded with respect to registration and accommodations. To ensure representation from all areas of the state, every effort will be made to enroll participants from all four (4) OEA regions.
