

The basic criteria for entrance into the Emerging Leaders Program (ELP) were established in order to guarantee opportunities for new member involvement. The desired outcome is to attract participants who:

- ✓ exhibit an interest in acquiring and utilizing leadership skills; and
- ✓ have held no position higher than a local Association Representative (AR).

Participants in the program may be self-nominated or nominated by others—local association leader, district leader, OEA Board of Directors member, or OEA Labor Relations Consultant. Participation will be fully funded with respect to registration and accommodations. To ensure representation from all areas of the state, every effort will be made to enroll participants from all four (4) OEA regions.

Objectives of the OEA Emerging Leaders Program

- ✓ To develop potential leaders for the educational institutions and locals of the future;
- ✓ To design a program that would create an awareness of the learning process, provide a basic introduction to various subjects and then build and enhance skills in those areas, and generate enthusiasm for continued growth and development;
- ✓ To communicate the spirit leadership and the skills needed for the task; and
- ✓ To provide an opportunity for young members to perceive themselves as capable and successful at the leadership level.
