# **TOPIC: Wellness fund**

The word is that Governor DeWine is going to extend the Wellness Fund in 2022-2023. If so, will you use more recent and accurate data than the outdated, inaccurate 2010 census?

# **TOPIC: Mental Health**

When a student expresses thoughts of suicide due to mental abuse at home, we are required to notify the student's parents (who are the abusers) of the students' intentions. This nearly always increases the student's trouble at home and makes them more inclined to harm themselves. What can be done about this?
